GOD GREW TIRED OF US - That is the title of the documentary film Catalyst will be watching on Wednesday, August 17. We will meet at church from 6-8:30PM. This heart-wrenching movie follows the lives of "the lost boys of Sudan" as they fled Sudan (27,000 boys fled), then Ethiopia, settled in Kenya (only 11,000 of the 27,000 boys survived), and finally to their refugee immigration to the US. Afterwards, high school teens from the mission trip will share their experiences from St. Louis with refugees and various opportunities we have in the Quad Cities to minister to a larger and larger refugee population. The movie is rated PG.
